Automatic air blast print and apply labeller with belt and touch screen.

Fully configurable and integrated with external software.

SOFTWARE

Machine management program

Program for printing and editing labels with Sw custom label image technology.

Selectable functions

- · 3 levels of login details with log-ins recorded on database
- Conveyor cycle processing mode (no labelling) or automatic labelling from below and/ or above (optional)
- Management of machine parameters (belt speed, delays and application parameters) from PLU database, with the option of adapting these features to each product in transit
- Management of printing information directly on the print layout, as fixed text and/or made variable either by selecting from the 'items with variables' database or reading text files, where both features provide the option of acquiring data from the network
- Possible use of html formatting tags for all texts, which allow the text style to be changed (bold, italic, underlined, etc.), supporting different types (fonts, alignments, sizes, bold, etc.) in the same text
- Driver configuration and management of the main features of the printing systems present, such as status and reset, feed, print last label and calibration commands
- Remote database management through the exchange of csv files in shared folders, with the option of importing the PLU master data, the list of all the labels and the variables printing information linked to them (items with variables database), and exporting the information on the processes carried out, showing the sequential number, the machine ID, the start date and time, the code and description of the item with variables (label), the printer used, the name of the label and the variables information linked to it (processing log database)
- Remote machine management via socket (IP address and port) with possible commands for status request, PLU selection for the product in transit, automation start/ stop, SAP On/Off and Label printing, SAP.AS On/Off and Label printing, Item selection with SAP variables and Item selection with SAP.AS variables
- · Multilingual selection
- Remote support
- Network-based machine management software with Label Server communication protocol (optional)
- Network-based software for editing labels (optional)

PLU

PLU number: 9999

Each PLU is made up of 11 fields comprising machine parameters and parameters of the two printing systems, namely:

- alphanumeric primary key of max. length 10, unique PLU ID code
- 1 text field with max. length of 50 characters, available for the description of the product to be used
- 1 integer field available for setting the machine speed
- 4 integer fields available for the SAP.AS printer for setting the application tape speed, application delay, number of copies and any delay between the copies
- 4 integer fields available for the SAP printer for setting the application delay, number of copies and any delay between the copies, pneumatic arm stroke

ITEM WITH VARIABLES

Number of variables or labels: 9999

Each variable is made up of 4 fields, namely:


- Alphanumeric primary key of max. length 10, unique ID code of the variable stored in the processing log
- 1 text field with max. length of 50 characters, available for the description of the variable used
- 1 text field with max. length of 500 characters, available for indicating the name of the print format used
- 1 text field with max. length of 4000 characters, available for containing the variables printing information used in the label

Note: in processing mode with information from a file, the same information viewed for items with variables is managed by a group of text files available for each printing system present, respectively code.txt, description.txt, infovar.txt, layout.txt, present in the respective data exchange folders to be managed over the network
